Procedure Report

The procedure, risks, benefits and alternatives were explained to the patient. Questions were answered and a consent for the insertion of testosterone/pellet implants was signed.

An area in the _____ was prepped with betadine swabs. A sterile drape was applied. 1% lidocaine with/wo epinephrine with sodium bicarbonate was used to anestitize the area. A small transverse incision was made using a number 11 blade. The trocar with cannula was passed through the incision into the subcutaneous tissue. _____ mg. testosterone pellet(s) were inserted through the cannula into the subcutaneous tissue. Bleeding was minimal. Steri-strips were applied. A sterile dressing was applied. The patient tolerated the procedure well. Post-operative instructions were reviewed and a copy given to the patient.
